

# How to Start a Business Conversation in English: A Beginner's Guide for Japanese Professionals

Perfect for those first-time meetings, introductions, or any conversation with international colleagues!

## 1. How's Your Day Going So Far?

A simple and friendly way to start any meeting or conversation.

**Example:** "How's your day going so far?"

7 日本語訳:「今日はどうですか?」

# 2. What Brings You to This Meeting?

Use this to get to the **point** of the conversation.

Example: "What brings you to this meeting today?"

7日本語訳:「今日はどうしてこのミーティングに参加されたのですか?」

## 3. Have You Worked with Our Team Before?

A good icebreaker for learning about the other person's **experience**.

**SEXAMPLE:** "Have you worked with our team before?"

行日本語訳:「これまでに私たちのチームと一緒に働いたことはありますか?」

## 4. Is This Your First Time Working on a Project Like This?

Ideal for **new projects** and when you want to know their level of experience.

**> Example:** "Is this your first time working on a project like this?"

**7 日本語訳:「こういったプロジェクトは初めてですか?」** 

## 5. How Long Have You Been with the Company?

This one helps you understand how long someone has been in the organization.

**Solution** Example: "How long have you been with the company?"

**7 日本語訳:「その会社にはどのくらい勤めているんですか?」** 

## 6. What's Your Role in This Project?

Understanding the **roles** of everyone involved in the conversation.

**Example:** "What's your role in this project?"

有日本語訳:「このプロジェクトでの役割は何ですか?」

#### 7. How's the Weather Over There?

Classic small talk that **opens the door** to a comfortable conversation.

**Example:** "How's the weather over there?"

7 日本語訳:「そちらの天気はどうですか?」

## 8. I've Heard Great Things About Your Team.

A great way to **compliment** and open up the conversation.

**Section Example:** "I've heard great things about your team!"

**7 日本語訳:「あなたのチームの評判、よく聞いています!」** 

# 9. What's It Like Working in [Location]?

Great for **international conversations** when talking about places.

🗣 Example: "What's it like working in Tokyo?"

7 日本語訳:「東京で働くのはどうですか?」

## 10. Is There Anything You'd Like to Share with the Team?

Encouraging others to **speak up** during a conversation.

**Example:** "Is there anything you'd like to share with the team?"

百日本語訳:「チームと共有したいことはありますか?」

# 11. How's the Project Going?

A simple question to **check in** and get an update.

**Example:** "How's the project going?"

**有** 日本語訳:「プロジェクトは順調ですか?」

#### 12. Let's Get Started!

A great way to **begin** a meeting or conversation with energy.

**Example:** "Let's get started with the discussion!"

# 13. Shall We Begin?

A more formal way to **start** a meeting or session.

**Example:** "Shall we begin the meeting?"

7日本語訳:「ミーティングを始めてもよろしいですか?」

## 14. Let's Take This Offline.

Use this to **move the discussion** to a later time or private setting.

Example: "Let's take this offline and discuss it later."

**7 日本語訳:「この件については後で別途話しましょう。」** 

## 15. Can You Explain That in More Detail?

Use this when you want a **clearer explanation** of something.

**Example:** "Can you explain that in more detail?"

6 日本語訳:「もう少し詳しく説明していただけますか?」

### 16. I Look Forward to Working with You.

Perfect for showing enthusiasm about a **new collaboration**.

🗫 Example: "I look forward to working with you on this project."

**万** 日本語訳:「このプロジェクトで一緒に仕事ができるのを楽しみにしています。」

#### 17. Thank You for Your Time.

A great way to **express appreciation** after a meeting.

**Example:** "Thank you for your time today!"

**7** 日本語訳:「今日はお時間いただきありがとうございました!」

# 18. Let Me Follow Up on That.

Use this when you want to **check in** or continue a discussion.

Parample: "Let me follow up with you after the meeting."

**7 日本語訳:「ミーティング後に再度ご連絡いたします。」** 

## 19. Can We Schedule Another Meeting?

When more discussion is needed, you can schedule another meeting.

**Solution Example:** "Can we schedule another meeting next week?"

行日本語訳:「来週、もう一度ミーティングを予定できますか?」

# 20. I'll Get Back to You Shortly.

Use this when you're not sure about something but will follow up soon.

**Example:** "I'll get back to you shortly with an update."

**有**日本語訳:「すぐにアップデートをお送りします。」
